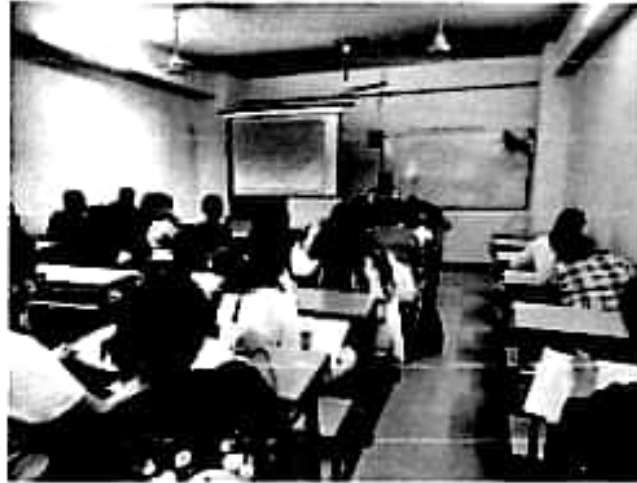

Report on the Seminar: "The Role of Artificial Intelligence in Intellectual Property Law" on 12th & 13th January 2024

REPORT

Seminar: International Literacy day – 8th September 2023

Knowledge and continuance practice of such advocacy skills will help an advocate to be successful in his/her career.


At the end of the seminar, students were given an opportunity to ask questions, there was active participation by the students. The queries raised by them were catered in detail by the speaker.




session. Students inquired and cleared their doubts on various issues relating to the Career options, which was answered by the Guest of Honour.
