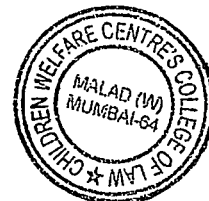

Report on Seminar on Legal Awareness on *Rights of Persons with Disabilities* on 16th December 2023

A seminar on Legal Awareness on *Rights of Persons with Disabilities* was successfully organized at the Children Welfare Centre College of Law, bringing together students, faculty, and legal professionals to discuss an important and often underrepresented subject. The event aimed to shed light on the rights, entitlements, and legal protections provided to persons with disabilities under the Act and to highlight the collective responsibility of society in ensuring their inclusion, dignity, and equality.

The program began with a warm welcome by the master of ceremonies, who introduced the theme of the seminar and emphasized its relevance in today's world. The keynote speaker, Advocate R. Satyanarayannan, a distinguished expert in disability rights and advocacy, was introduced to the audience. Advocate Satyanarayannan commenced his address with an overview of the *Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016*, delving into its evolution as a landmark legislation aimed at aligning India's legal framework with international conventions, particularly the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities.

The speaker elaborated on several key aspects of the Act, such as the broadened definition of disability to include 21 specified conditions, the emphasis on equality and non-discrimination, and the obligation of both public and private entities to provide accessibility and accommodations. Advocate Satyanarayan also discussed provisions related to inclusive education, employment opportunities, and social security measures for persons with disabilities. He highlighted the establishment of institutional mechanisms such as the Chief Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities to oversee implementation and resolve grievances.

REPORT ON CHAMBER VISIT BY LAW STUDENTS ON 25TH AND 26TH SEPTEMBER 2023

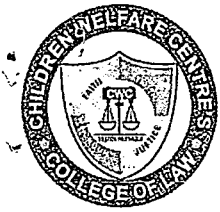
