#### REPORT

A Seminar on Prevention of Sexual Harassment Act, 2013 – 14th October 2023

The Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension of Children Welfare Centre's College of Law had organised a seminar on Prevention of Sexual Harassment act 2013 on 14<sup>th</sup> October 2023. The Speaker for the event was Adv. Paathik Muni and Adv. Kamal Muni.

The discourse surrounding gender equality and the prevention of sexual harassment has gained significant momentum. To address this pressing issue, CWC's College of Law had organised a seminar focused on the Prevention of Sexual Harassment Act, 2013. The seminar aimed at providing a comprehensive understanding of the legal framework, its implications, and strategies for effective implementation within the Indian legal system and the corporate world in India. - 3. <u>Strategies for Prevention</u>: The seminar underscored the importance of preventive measures, emphasizing the role of educational institutions in cultivating a culture of respect and consent. The students and the faculty engaged in discussions on implementing sensitization programs and awareness campaigns within the college.
- 4. <u>The ICC's Role</u>: An in-depth exploration of the Internal Complaints Committee's composition, functions, and the significance of maintaining confidentiality and protection for complainants provided valuable insights for the participants.
- 5. <u>Addressing Challenges and Proposing Solutions</u>: The students and faculty actively discussed challenges faced in the effective implementation of the POSH Act, including common misconceptions and institutional barriers. Strategies for overcoming these challenges were collaboratively explored.
- 6. <u>Case Studies</u>: The event incorporated interactive sessions where participants, guided by speakers, engaged in discussions on hypothetical scenarios. Real-life case studies were analysed, offering practical insights into the complexities of dealing with sexual harassment issues.
